- As a quick reminder, wage-earning taxpayers who earn less than \$75,000 single or \$150,000 married filing jointly, should notice slightly higher paychecks. Employers should have received or downloaded new IRS tax withholding tables that are adjusted for the Making Work Pay credit of \$400 or \$800 (married filing joint). When you file your 2009 tax return, you can claim the credit that equals the reduced withholding.
- Pensioners and other non wage-earning taxpayers should be aware that withholding changes may result in smaller refunds for 2009 taxes. Those who usually receive very small refunds could end up owing tax in 2009. Please feel free to contact us with any concerns or questions as you might wish to increase your withholdings.



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
